Discuss and Consider Approval of Minutes for December 18, 2019 Meeting

Discuss and Consider Request for Proposal Related to Motor Coach Bus Rentals and Yellow Bus Rentals

Mr. Terry Marak shared the bid information with the Board. ESC Region 12 management recommends that the Board accept the Motor Coach Bus bids from Arrow, Echo, and Sam's Limo. Approving three Motor Coach bids enables the Center to obtain the best price and ensure that a bus will be available at all times. We also request that the Board approve Durham for the Yellow Bus rentals. The Board unanimously approved all bids.

Discuss and Consider Request for Proposal Related to Upward Bound High School Student Trip to Boston, Massachusetts

Mr. Terry Marak explained that ESC Region 12's Upward Bound grant issued an RFP for a student trip to Boston, MA. Region 12 received three responses and based on the evaluation summary, the ESC Region 12 management requests that the Board approve All Aboard Tours and Travel's all-inclusive Boston student trip package. The Board unanimously approved the bid from All Aboard Tours and Travel.
